Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope you have all enjoyed a restful Christmas holiday. We hope the children are excited to be back in 2025!

Our PE days for this half term are **Monday** and **Friday.** The children may continue to wear their PE kit to school on these days; consisting of plain <u>navy</u> or school-branded navy hooded, <u>white</u> t-shirt, <u>black</u> shorts or tracksuit bottoms and <u>black</u> trainers. As the weather changes, the children should bring a coat to school every day. They will also need a water bottle that can be refilled at school.

In **English,** we will be focusing on writing our own poetry as part of our sequence using the book Lost words. This will be followed by learning around Short stories. In **Maths** will see us learning about Multiplication and division, before moving on to decimals and percentages. The children will continue to use Times tables rock stars to help with their timetables recall and participate in the around the world challenge on Fridays.

This term, Year 5 will study **Science, Geography, Art, Computing, PE, RE, PSHE, Music**. The details of the sequences can be found on the class page of our website. The subject overviews contain the learning objectives, key vocabulary, prior learning and where this sequence fits in the children's journey through the subject. These overviews will also feature at the start of the sequence in the children's books and files. They will be familiar with the information that they contain and would provide a useful prompt for conversations at home. A spelling list will be sent home for the term and displayed on the classroom to allow children to see them in class as well as at home. We will complete our weekly spelling checks on Wednesdays.
