Prior Knowledge

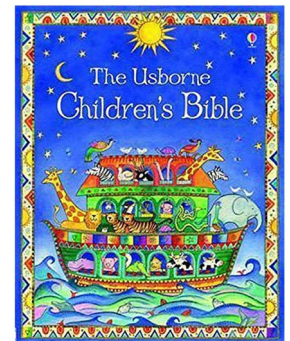
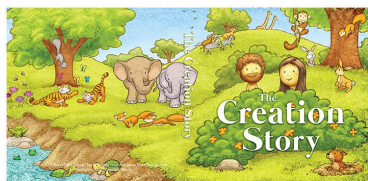
