RE: Year 3 Exeter Educational Visit - Tuesday 8th October

We have arranged for Year 3 to visit Exeter on Tuesday 8th October. The purpose of the trip is to learn more about the history of Exeter and Devon, which will feed into our topic of the UK in Geography. Specifically, we will be visiting the cathedral and comparing it to our local church. Following our visit will then go to Pizza Express for lunch.

Transport

We will travel to Exeter by train from Eggesford station, leaving on the 9.01am train. Children need to be at the station by 8.45am at the latest. Staff will be available there from 8.30am to enable you to drop other siblings to school.

We will return to Eggesford at 2.57pm, enabling time to return to school to collect any siblings. We greatly appreciate your support with transport to enable the children to have this brilliant experience. In the past, parents have organised car shares amongst themselves, school is unable to do this on your behalf. Please let us know if someone else is collecting/dropping your child for safeguarding reasons.

Clothing

The children need to wear their school uniform for the trip. They also need a coat and sensible shoes (trainers) for walking. Each child will need a water bottle which they can carry in a small rucksack. Lunch is provided. The children will not need any additional items or spending money. Please no glass, fizzy drinks and definitely no sweets.

Cost

The price of the visit will be £11.50 per child. We have been able to subsidise this trip with fundraising by Friends of Winkleigh helping to reduce the cost. We have to carefully cost each trip, and this does mean that our costings rely upon every child attending. If your circumstances are such that you are unable to pay this contribution, please contact the school to discuss this in confidence.

A payment request has been set up in the gateway, please login to give consent and pay you contribution by Friday 27th September 2024.

Please can we remind you that it is your responsibility to contact admin to cancel your child's meal, Early Birds or All Sorts bookings if they are on a trip and will not be in school for any of the above.

We are looking forward to a fantastic trip.
